

Welcome to the 2010 PNRC-NAHRO Scholarship Golf Tournament at Salem Golf Club in Salem, OR



In conjunction with its 2010 Annual Conference in Salem, OR April 25-28th, PNRC-NAHRO will hold its Annual Scholarship Golf Tournament on **Sunday, April 25th** to raise funds for the scholarships awarded yearly to residents of our members' affordable housing programs. This year's Tournament at **Salem Golf Club in Salem, OR** is less than three miles from the Salem Conference Center and Grand Phoenix Hotel. The Salem Golf Club offers terrain suitable for golfers at all skill levels. The course is 6300 yards and features a great setting with mature tree-lined fairways. The tournament will begin with the first tee time at 8:45 AM on Sunday, April 25th. While we encourage serious golfers to participate in the Tournament, we also want to allow for some fun, so we added the usual "bells and whistles" to our tournament rules. The registration desk will sell "Mulligans" at one for \$5 or 3 for \$10, and "Tie a Knot" string at 3 feet for \$10 (to be used for missed putts). The Seventh Hole will be "Lucky Number 7" and each player must start and finish the hole using only a 7 iron (including putting).

Since this Tournament will **not** feature a shotgun start, it will not be possible to get everyone together at the end for lunch and awards. Instead, breakfast will be provided beginning at 7:45 AM before the Tournament starts. Awards will be presented at the Sunday evening Welcoming Reception at the Salem Conference Center. The cost of participating in the **breakfast only** (for non-golfers) is \$15.00 per person with advance registration required.

The cost of playing in the Tournament will be the same as last year --- \$85 per person (includes greens fees, carts, and breakfast). Those registering **foursomes** will pay **only \$80** per person. To encourage fund-raising for the tournament, **participants will receive a \$10 credit towards their registration for every \$100 of contributions raised through their efforts.** A participant raising \$400 in contributions would pay only \$45 to play; \$850 or more in contributions will mean the fund-raiser would play for free! Tournament sponsors will be recognized with signs on tees and greens and at the Annual Conference that begins Monday, April 26th.
