Dear Potential Golf Tournament Sponsor:

On Sunday, April 25, 2010, PNRC-NAHRO will hold its 7th Annual Golf Tournament at the Salem Golf Club in Salem, OR to raise money for our Resident Scholarship Program. Each year, PNRC-NAHRO awards scholarships to residents of our members' affordable housing programs (Public Housing, Section 8, Tax Credit, etc.). We offer one \$10,000 college scholarship, two \$4,000 college scholarships, and one \$2,000 community college scholarship to graduating high school seniors & one \$4,000 continuing education scholarship for residents seeking to return to school after being out of high school for four years.

At any given time, we will have as many as twenty-four scholarship recipient, low-income housing residents in our program. Without financial assistance such as that provided by PNRC-NAHRO, many of these individuals will not be able to pursue higher education opportunities.

Our scholarships are paid from PNRC-NAHRO's revenues and by contributions from corporate entities and individuals. Each year, in association with our Annual Conference, we hold fund-raising events with the proceeds going to support the Scholarship Program. This year's Golf Tournament will offer opportunities for those who wish to sponsor a "tee" or a "green" for \$300 or a "tee **and** a green" for \$450. Signs identifying sponsors will be placed on the course and sponsors will be recognized in our conference program.

PNRC-NAHRO is a non-profit organization (501 [c] 3) registered with the IRS so contributions to the Scholarship Program are tax-deductible depending on individual donors' tax situations. I hope that you or your organization will consider supporting our Scholarship Program with a contribution.
